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Board Elections - Directors

March 2014

An election for the three Board Corporation Officers is scheduled for 2014. The AHA Corporation Bylaws proscribes that Officers are elected in even number years (2014) and Directors are elected in odd number years (2015).

The AHA President, John Ruppel, appointed an Election Committee composed of Secretary-Treasurer Lt Col Dave Russell; CCMSgt Liliana Ramos; association member at large, Lt Col Jim Rommelfanger; and Newsletter Editor Lynda Fawcett. The committee will be responsible for gathering nominations, distributing, collecting, and counting the ballots. The newly elected Officers will be announced at the Association's annual meeting, the Annual Old Timers Lunch, scheduled for Tuesday, March 11, 2014, at the Castro Valley Loyal Order of Moose Hall, 20835 Rutledge Road, Castro Valley, CA 94546.

Any AHA member in good standing may serve as a Director. Individuals interested in serving as a Director should complete the form included in this issue. Return the completed form (or a reasonable facsimile) no later than January 15, 2014, to:

Nominations must be received by January 15, 2014, to be valid. All nominations will be included on the ballot. Ballots – an email or a self-addressed stamped postcard - will be sent to all members in good standing, with information regarding the Old Timers Luncheon, no later than February 15, 2014. There is no write-in provision. Ballots must be returned no later than March 7, 2014, to be valid. The nominees with the highest number of votes for each office will be declared Directors, and will be announced and begin their two-year term at the Old Timers Luncheon.



When Will Your Form 1099R Become Available?

The IRS Forms 1099R for the 2013 tax year will become available online in mid-December 2013. You will be able to access yours on *myPay*.

We will also mail hard copy versions of the 1099R to those who have chosen that option. Please keep in mind that hard copy versions of the 1099R are issued later and will take a while to reach you. If you have elected hard copy, you may not receive it until mid-January 2014.

Please note that 1099R's are not automatically issued for deceased members. If you want to receive a 1099R on the behalf of a member who passed away, a certificate of death must be on file, and you must request that a 1099R be issued.

The Board appreciates the members' response to the late dues notice. We have made progress in reducing the delinquencies. 
